Math Exit Expectations

Students will continue working on multiplying two-digit numbers by two- and three-digit numbers. Students will find multiples and factors of numbers and the LCM and GCF of a number pair.

Reading/Language Arts Exit Expectations

We are working on our third unit of study on inventors and artists. We have been working on author's purpose, compare and contrast, fact and opinion, and main idea and supporting details as we read the stories in this unit.

Students will be completing feature stories, expository and descriptive writing prompts. The conventions we are focusing on include the use of irregular verbs, prepositions and prepositional phrases.

Science Exit Expectations

We will continue to study sound and light. Students will be able to explain how sound is caused by vibrations. They will also discover that pitch is affected by frequency and infer that sound travels in waves.

Social Studies Expectations

Students will understand the rights and responsibilities in the Bill of Rights. They will also be able to explain how a bill becomes a law at the federal level.

Religion Expectations

We have taken a look at the Catholic Church Liturgical Calendar and the seasons that are celebrated by our faith. We will use the Great Commandment and the four cardinal virtues as ways to prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ in our lives. We will also practice what we have learned about living a life of virtue to making good moral decisions in our lives.
